Goal of Project:

To stabilize the creek bank on Hay Creek to prevent continued erosion and prevent potential loss of valuable recreational resources and riparian habitat.

Work Accomplished:

Creek realignment and bank erosion stabilization, the outer bank in specific areas was armored with riprap to prevent further erosion. Area disturbed during construction were reseeded to reestablish vegetation and stabilize soil erosion.

Project Results:

This area of Hay Creek has been stabilized and the adjustment has been established.

Value to North Dakota:

By stabilizing the creek bank it secures riparian habitat for the future and helps improve water quality, this area is utilized by wildlife and the public to enjoy the environment.
