Goal of Project*:

The goal of the Clear Lake Park grain bin gazebos and tree planting project was to make the park more desirable for families to utilize and enjoy the outdoors. Clear Lake is a small park but with the added trees and the grain bin gazebos for shade has enhanced the look of the park and really has increased the attendance on the weekends. A Facebook account is established under ClearLake ND News if you want to take a peak at the families enjoying the new grain gazebos and the trees growing.

Work Accomplished*:

The Park was busy making improvements in 2022 year. The grain bins totaled \$37,000 for the supplies, moving and cost of putting them up. Otherwise the grain bins were donated. The trees were planted/installed totaling \$25,352.75 with a quantity of 10-6' colorado spruces, 10-6' ponderosa pines, 24-10' medora junipers along with the stakes and wood chips. The next few years will be kept busy with the trees with watering and ground maintenance and the never ending weed pulling,

Project Results*:

The results are amazing on the look and feel of the park after both projects were completed. The trees will add protection and beauty to the park along with the grain bins supplying shade and supply somewhere to retreat from the water when needed. Both these projects were a great addition to Clear Lake and wouldn't have been possible without the funding of Outdoor Heritage grant. We thank you for allowing us to receive the money.

Value to North Dakota*:

The value to North Dakota with putting money into parks gives the tourists and people of Mountrail County and surrounding communities a place to have a retreat from the every day hectic life. The Heritage Fund was publicly acknowledged in both the Mountrail County Promoter (local paper) and Facebook at ClearLake ND News on July 28, 2021.
