Contract 006-089 has been completed. The Minot Retriever Club is returning the unused commitment of \$51,280.00.

Here is a breakdown of the use of the grounds.

In 2016 over July 8 - 10, 75 people and 168 dogs used the grounds. This was our scheduled AKC Hunt Test

The 2016 Field Trial which was held August 12-13, we had 42 people and 55 dogs

The 2017 AKC Hunt Test on July 7,8 and 9 had 80 people and 185 dogs

The 2017 AKC Field Trial on August 12 - 13 had 26 people and 61 dogs

During the summer there are people on the grounds training. More people use the grounds on the weekend. Weekends usually sees 7 or 8 people working dogs. There is not a sign in sheet, so it is hard to say how many people are on the grounds Monday through Friday. There is somebody on the grounds just about every day during the summer.

In addition, we have people from across the upper Midwest traveling to different dog events that stop and use the grounds to exercise or do some quick training before heading to the next event. The Bismarck NAVDA dog club will be using the grounds to host dog training seminars this summer.

We feel that the OHF funds have been put to good use and grounds are being used by the public
