Enclosed is our Outdoor Heritage Fund Grant Application from the Devils Lake Park District for a dock, boat slips and gangway on the east side of Creel Bay on Devils Lake next to the Creel Bay Golf Course Clubhouse. This project is a much needed amenity for fisherman and boaters that use Creel Bay and the waters of Devils Lake to enable them to take a break from being on the water to have a bite to eat or some beverages or even to stop and just relax or go golfing without having to take their boat off the lake.

Outdoor Heritage Fund Grant Application



The purpose of the North Dakota Outdoor Heritage Fund is to provide funding to state agencies, tribal governments, political subdivisions, and nonprofit organizations, with higher priority given to projects that enhance conservation practices in this state by:

Directive A. Providing access to private and public lands for sportsmen, including projects that create fish and wildlife habitat and provide access for sportsmen;

Directive B. Improving, maintaining and restoring water quality, soil conditions, plant diversity, animal systems and by supporting other practices of stewardship to enhance farming and ranching;

Directive C. Developing, enhancing, conserving and restoring wildlife and fish habitat on private and public lands; and

Directive D. Conserving natural areas and creating other areas for recreation through the establishment and development of parks and other recreation areas.

Exemptions

Outdoor Heritage Fund grants may not be used to finance the following:

- A. Litigation;
- B. Lobbying activities;
- C. Any activity that would interfere, disrupt, or prevent activities associated with surface coal mining operations; sand, gravel, or scoria extraction activities; oil and gas operations; or other energy facility or infrastructure development;
- D. The acquisition of land or to encumber any land for a term longer than twenty years; or
- E. Projects outside this state or projects that are beyond the scope of defined activities that fulfill the purposes of Chapter 54-17.8 of the North Dakota Century Code.

NO CONSIDERATION:

In addition to those specific items in law that are ineligible for funding, in the absence of a finding of exceptional circumstances by the Industrial Commission, the following projects will NOT receive consideration for funding:

- A completed project or project commenced before the grant application is submitted;
- A feasibility or research study;
- Maintenance costs;
- A paving project for a road or parking lot;
- A swimming pool or aquatic park;
- Personal property that is not affixed to the land;
- Playground equipment, except that grant funds may be provided for up to 25% of the cost of the equipment not exceeding \$10,000 per project and all playground equipment grants may not exceed 5% of the total grants per year (see Budget Form for how this will be calculated);
- Staffing or outside consultants except for costs for staffing or an outside consultant to design and implement an approved project based on the documented need of the applicant and the expenditures may not exceed 5% of the grant to a grantee if the grant exceeds \$250,000 and expenditures may not exceed 10% of the grant to a grantee if the grant is \$250,000 or less (see Budget Form for how this will be calculated);

- A building except for a building that is included as part of a comprehensive conservation plan for a new or expanded recreational project (see Budget Form for definition of comprehensive conservation plan and new or expanded recreational project); or
- A project in which the applicant is not directly involved in the execution and completion of the project.

Creel Bay Dock and Boat Slip Project

This project would add a floating dock and boat slips and a gangway on the east side of Creel Bay on Devils Lake next to the Creel Bay Golf Course Clubhouse to allow boaters and fisherman to park their boats to have lunch and beverages or even golf a round on the Creel Bay Golf Course that is owned by the Devils Lake Park District. With the heavy boat traffic and fisherman that use the Creel Bay area this would allow these boaters and fisherman to take a break from being on the lake without having to load their boat on their trailer and going to the City of Devils Lake for lunch.

There would have to be a few dead trees removed along the shoreline but the dock and boat slips would be located about 150 feet from the Creel Bay Clubhouse. We have received permission from the City of Devils Lake and the Corp of Engineers to place the gangway over the dike that protects the golf course from the high waters of Devils Lake. We have had hundreds of boaters and golfers that have asked us to add this project for their convenience.

The project would be completed in the spring or summer of 2019 and would include some tree removal, placing the dock and boat slips and adding the gangway. The

gangway would stay in place over the winter months but the floating dock and boat slips would be pulled over to the marina at Woodland Resort and stored for the winter. Once the project is completed we would request funds from the Industrial Commission.

The Devils Lake Park District is a political subdivision for the Devils Lake area that provides many facilities, amenities and programs for all ages for our local area. The Park District runs all youth and adult recreational programs in the Devils Lake area including the Creel Bay Golf Course as well as a park and beach located on the east edge of Creel Bay.

We are run by a 5-member Board of Commissioners and have 8 full-time staff and up to 150 part-time workers throughout the year. The Devils Lake Park District has been in existence since the 1920's and our mission is to promote and provide broad-based recreational programs, facilities and amenities to all the citizens of Devils Lake and the Lake Region area in order to improve the quality of life in our area.

There is only on other place on lake in this area that provides a place to park your boat and have a place to eat. This would be a new project, however, prior to the lake rising over 25 feet the last 20+ years there were docks in this area for boaters to stop and eat. Now that the lake is stabilized we would like once again to provide this access to boaters and fisherman again.

The project will be managed by the Devils Lake Park District Maintenance Staff and we install the dock and boat slips with help from the company that we purchase the equipment from. We will hire a local company that will come and remove the dead trees that are in the water next to the shoreline where this project will be installed. Our maintenance staff will maintain this facility as is needed and remove the floating dock and boat slip each fall and reinstall in the spring.

We will monitor how many people will use this amenity and we would expect this to be very well used by boaters as we have had many requests over the last couple of years asking that we provide a place for boaters to stop and use our facility for a place to eat and also taking a break to golf or just relax at the Clubhouse.

In-kind services used to match the request for Outdoor Heritage Fund dollars shall be valued as follows:

Playground equipment calculation - Only the actual costs of the playground equipment (a bid or invoice showing the amount of the equipment costs must be provided) - cannot include freight or installation or surface materials or removal of old equipment, etc.

Staffing/Outside Consultants Costs - If you are requesting OHF funding for staffing or for an outside consultant, you must provide information in your application on the need for OHF funding to cover these costs. For example, if you are an entity that has engineering staff you must explain why you don't have sufficient staff to do the work or if specific expertise is needed or whatever the reason is for your entity to retain an outside consultant. 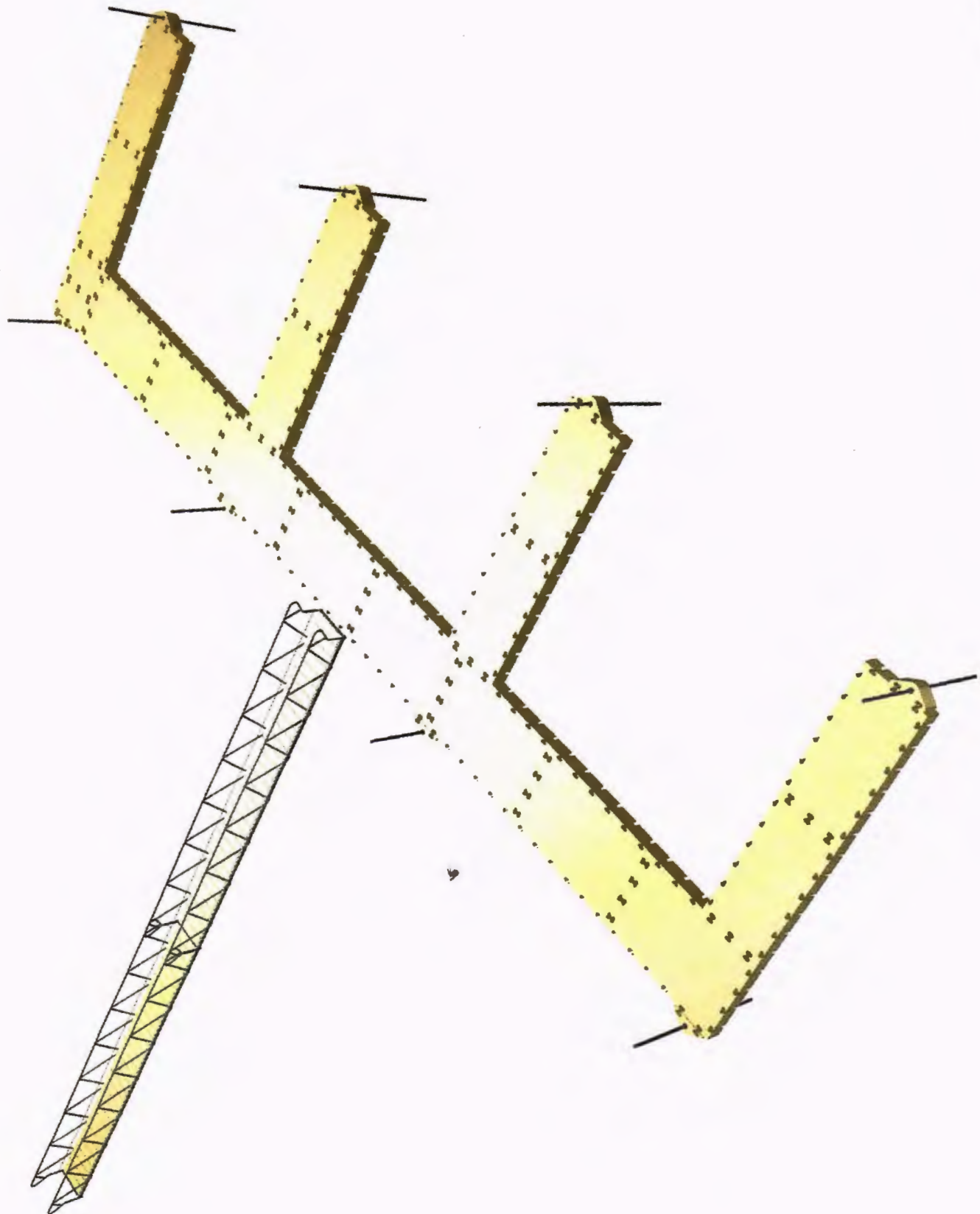

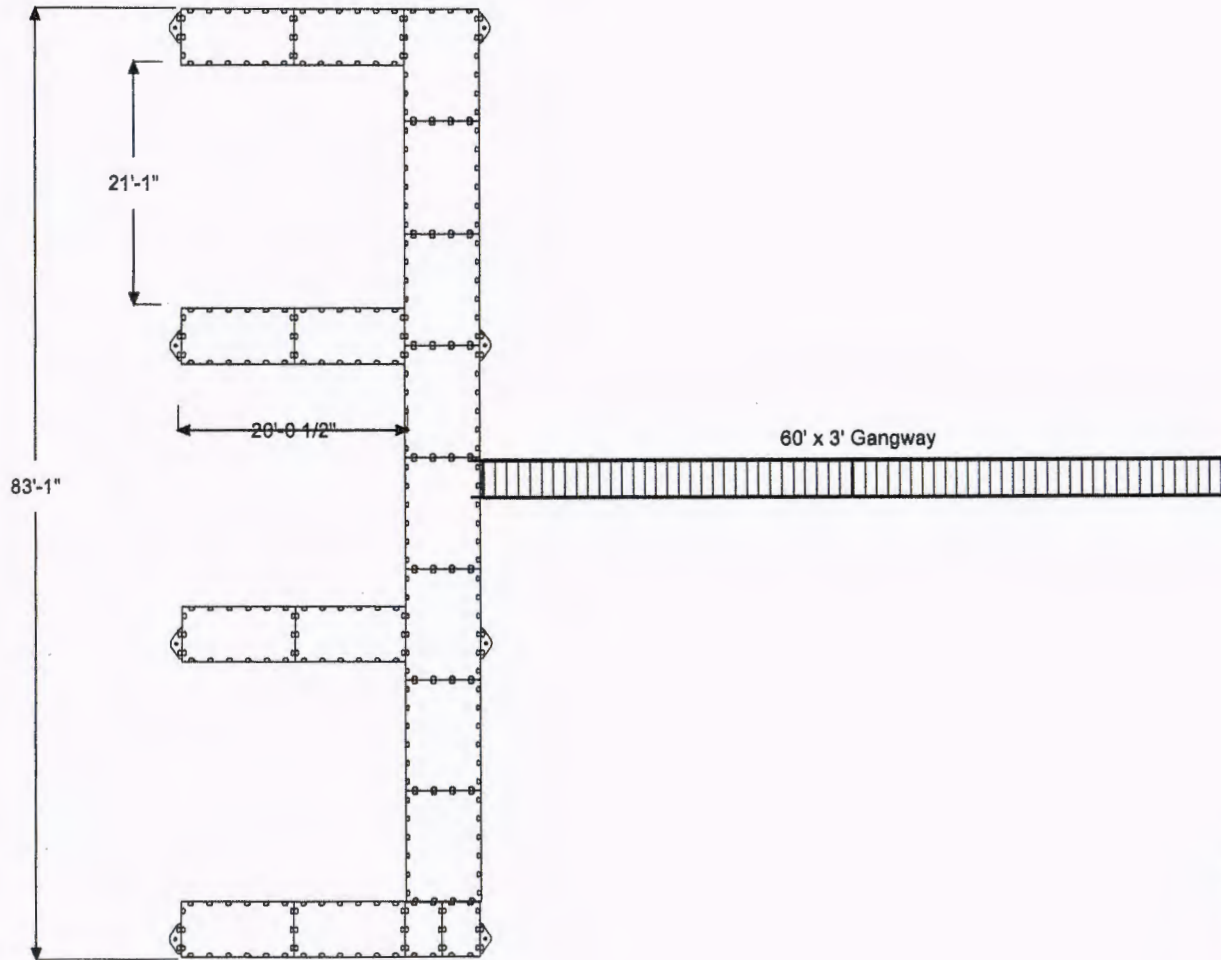

Dear Mr. Wallace,

The Devils Lake Convention and Visitors Bureau is in full support of your proposed project to include boat slips, gangway and dock at the Creel Bay Golf Course. Recreational boating has become more popular on Devils Lake and this would be a great fit for our community.

Devils Lake has been known in the past and present as a fishing destination but it has become even more popular as a family destination for recreation as well. The added amenities this would add to the boater would be a great addition and selling point to our community. We could use more recreational opportunities on the lake.

This project would also increase traffic to the golf course. It is a great place for the golfer, but this amenity would add additional revenue in food and beverage sales to the Park Board as well.

Please let me know if you need any assistance with this project. It will be a great selling feature for us to include for next summer.

Whereas, the Creel Bay Golf Course Clubhouse is located in an ideal area for boaters and fishermen that use Creel Bay for their recreational purposes,


Whereas, there has been an increasing demand from our local citizens and tourists to have a place on the lake to park their boats for food, drinks and golfing during the open lake period,


