The Walsh County Water Resource District (WCWRD) completed Phase 3 of the Park River Snagging and Clearing Project. This request is for final project cleanup completed by the contractor, Berger Enterprises. This project improved 5.8 river miles within the Park River by removing unfavorable debris. The project reduces riverbank erosion, allows for unrestricted flow, and enhances water quality within the Park River. Table 1 provides a cost-share breakdown for this request.
