Phase 1 of the Park River Snagging and Clearing project concluded on February 22, 2018. Successfully meeting Natural Resource Conservation Service Standards for Clearing and Snagging, 3.8 river miles were cleared of unfavorable debris. Following debris removal, debris was properly disposed and project cleanup was carried out, successfully meeting requirements for certification. This project enabled us to reduce riverbank erosion, maintain unrestricted flow, and enhance water quality within the Park River.
