The first prescribed fire management was executed on ½ the project acres during the spring of 2018 which represents the in-kind contribution. Some herbicide management was included to control noxious weeds.

168.76 acres are enrolled in the ND PLOTS program

0 Acres of seed harvest during 2018 - Seed harvest will commence in 2019.

The prescribed fire on 100 acres during 2018 advanced the development of the tallgrass prairie and eliminated many weeds. Fire will be expanded in 2019 onto over 140 acres.


