## North Dakota Forest Service Statewide Windbreak Renovation Initiative Outdoor Heritage Fund Project Number 005-074 Project Update June 30, 2018

On July 15, 2015, NDFS received a grant from the North Dakota Outdoor Heritage Fund for \$1,800,000 to support this initiative. 100% of this money will be distributed to North Dakota landowners to support windbreak renovation projects. Each windbreak renovation project will follow a written windbreak renovation plan utilizing best management practices.

## **Technical Assistance**

NDFS staff and partners offer technical assistance to interested landowners in the form of an on-site windbreak assessment and a written windbreak renovation plan. Renovation plans utilize a variety of forestry best management practices to meet the landowner's goals in restoring the functionality of the windbreak.

Requests for assistance are received through an online questionnaire. This questionnaire asks the landowner to answer a few simple questions including landowner contact information and the location of the windbreak in need of renovation. Questionnaires are grouped into "pools" based on the date that the document was received. NDFS is currently accepting questionnaires for the 5th pool – this pool officially closed on April 30, 2018. However, the few requests submitted since then are close to other requested site locations and will be scheduled concurrently with previous assistance requests. Assistance will be provided as our currently reduced staff are able to provide it. Questionnaires received after August 15, 2018 will receive technical assistance in 2019.

As of June 30, 2018, NDFS has received over 680 total requests for windbreak renovation planning assistance statewide.

## **Financial Assistance**

Following the windbreak assessment and written renovation plan, NDFS staff assist landowners with applying for cost share assistance to implement the windbreak renovation project. There is no deadline to apply and applications are accepted on a continual basis. Landowners have a minimum of two full years to complete their renovation project and apply for reimbursement.

As of June 30, 2018, NDFS has awarded grants totaling \$1,134,452.51 to 214 projects statewide, and 74 of these projects have been completed. The completed projects provide direct protection to 61 rural farmsteads and 490 acres of farmland.
