Pheasants Forever (PF) spent the majority of their time this reporting period working to plan projects for Spring of 2017. Pheasants Forever has 4 projects tentatively planned for the Spring of 2017 located near Garrison, Crystal Springs, Beulah, and Tioga. These plantings will be done on a variety of different sites including a Wildlife Management Area, North Dakota State Park, local trap range and a bible camp. Pheasants Forever chapters intend to work with the following youth groups to help plan and establish the projects: 2017 Envirothon teams, Garrison Cub Scouts, Beulah 5th Grade, and we are working on identifying a youth group in Tioga. Project planning incudes: communicating with the youth groups about the project, going over the curriculum with the teacher, conducting site preparation on the project site (herbicide application), creating seed mixes, and ordering seed. Pheasants Forever staff has spent a total of 137 hours assisting chapters with planning upcoming events and promoting program.
