The North Dakota Petroleum Council, in cooperation with the Outdoor Heritage Fund, ONEOK, Whiting Oil and Gas and private landowners planted more than 58,000 trees in Burleigh, Kidder, Dickey, Morton, Mountrail, Emmons, Wells, Grant, Stark and Sheridan Counties. This surpasses the program's goal of planting 55,000 trees over the course of three years. Eighteen landowners participated in the project and the average planting was approximately 3,200 trees. In partnership with industry partners, the OHF, and private landowners, we were able to plant trees for an average cost of \$1.25, allowing our dollars to go further than expected.

Although Planting for the Future met and surpassed its goals, funds remain to allow the program to plant more trees in the 2019 planting season. We have received another 22 applications for trees next year. The program will be working to raise additional funds from industry to help fund as many of these projects as possible in 2019.
