To date we have been working on finalizing the designs for the maps and information as well as public land signs. We have identified kiosk and sign locations and coordinated work efforts for installing kiosk and signs this upcoming spring.

Plans are to have the maps and kiosks printed this winter as well as order the needed signs in advance of the spring season and acquire the needed signs to be placed along the river segment that notifies the public of when they are entering and leaving public lands.

The bulk of the instillation work is scheduled for the spring season with plans expending grant funds and unveiling the completed Sheyenne River Water Trail by mid-summer well in advance of the December 31st, 2019.
