Graner Park Bank Stabilization (Phase II) has been completed. Several trees and stumps have been removed and stored in Graner Park for future use as campfire firewood. The project has reshaped 585 linear feet of Missouri River bank to a 2:1 slope. Existing rip-rap material totaling approximately 800 tons were removed and fractured for reuse. The 2:1 slope was covered by 1,560 square yards of Geotextile Fabric. In addition to the approximate 800 tons of rip-rap material that was reused, 700 tons of rip-rap material was hauled in and placed.
