The Cass County Windbreak & Wildlife Planting Initiative successfully planted 82,550 linear feet of trees in Cass County for the 2019 planting season. This project successfully created 30 acres of trees for wildlife habitat and wind protection. We reached 63% of the footage goal after the first year of implementation and still have 43% of the budget remaining for next year.

In 2020, the project successfully implemented 60,160 linear feet of tree plantings. The plantings created roughly 16 acres of woodland habitat with 8,860 trees being planted in the program.

Cumulatively over the 2 year project, The Cass County Windbreak & Wildlife Planting Initiative successfully planted 142,710 linear feet of trees creating roughly 46 acres of wildlife habitat totaling 21,786 trees planted.
