There was a scheduling delay as the contractor for the installation of the septic systems had a backlog of work. However, the septic systems are now installed and ready for usage.

Work Completed during Period Covered by Report:

The Turtle Mountain Band of Chippewa contracted with Mr. Jerry Bercier was hired to put in the self-contained septic system needed for each rest room unit. These systems are self-contained and each of the three systems is supplied with an 800 gallon holding tank. The systems do not require a drain field which could otherwise allow leakage into the lake watershed areas. A local tribal sanitation firm will clean out the septic system at least once yearly. The septic systems were installed in July of 2019.

The tribe contracted with Mr. Ron Parisien, Tribal College Carpentry Instructor, to construct the three (3) rest room units. Mr. Parisien employed several college carpentry students to assist. The materials were purchased at Monroe Builders in Rolla, ND. The rest rooms are currently under construction and are near complete. Each unit has two bathrooms – one for woman and one for men. They are constructed using wood framing and metal siding inside and out. There are ventilation windows installed and the toilets are made of stainless steel for commercial applications.

One unit is sized 10' x 24' to accommodate a changing area for individuals wanting to swim and for use during pow wows and events. This unit will be located on Gordon Lake's main beach swimming area. The other two units are sized 10' x 16' and will be located at the Wheaton and Gordon Lake fishing dock areas.

The rest room units are expected to be completed and ready for use by the public by the end of August, 2019. Signage will be placed on each Rest Room to recognize the North Dakota Outdoor Heritage Fund's financial contribution to the project.
