LaMoure Lions purchased innovative playground equipment to inspire outdoor recreation for North Dakotans of all ages. We collaborated with a licensed landscape architect to create an attractive and thoughtfully designed layout for the new playground equipment and to enhance public use of Sunset Park. That planning also included specs for a new 8' concrete walkway from the street to the new playground to provide access for all users inclusive of mobility needs.

May 2019: LaMoure Lions hired a contractor to prep the new site including excavation, labor, and installation of rebar for the 8' sidewalk as well as a 4' concrete border around the play area for multipurpose use: walking, pedaling, etc.

May 2019: LaMoure Lions coordinated a community build involving over 100 volunteers who assembled and installed the new equipment. We hired a certified playground technician to advise and oversee day one of installation. Lions members also hired contractors and equipment and organized additional volunteers to install 3" of pea rock and several hundred cubic yards of engineered wood fibers to meet the fill requirements necessary for the fall heights of the new equipment.

September 2019: LaMoure Park Board moved dirt from the excavation to slope ground around the newly installed sidewalk leading to and surrounding the play area.

October 2019: LaMoure Lions hired the playground technician to inspect installation from the community build and ensure all pieces were properly installed and safe. LaMoure Lions pumped water from the play area due to excessive rainfall that led to standing water in the play area.

October, 2019: LaMoure Lions purchased more engineered wood fibers and coordinated High School student volunteers to add the surfacing to the play area.

October, 2019: LaMoure Lions hired a contractor to complete concrete work around the play area. Lions ordered a commemorative bench to recognize the Outdoor Heritage Fund for partially funding this project.
