If yes, please explain:

We are requesting to extend this grant period until 12/31/2025. Although we have obligated more than 80% of the OHF's funding for more than 50 CCLIP2 projects, we anticipate a delayed completion date of some infrastructure development on remaining projects. Exceptional drought conditions in 2020 and 2021 have delayed well driller's schedules. We also observed delayed cover crop plantings due to the drought. Additionally, availability and cost of grazing infrastructure supplies have delayed completion of planned projects. Remaining flexible with cooperating landowners will be imperative for successful, long term adoption of regenerative conservation practices.

The Cover Crop & Livestock Integration Project II (CCLIP2) was designed to provide North Dakota farmers and ranchers with the financial assistance needed to kick-start sustainable agricultural practices that meet their operational goals and diversify their operations while improving soil health, water quality, grassland health, and wildlife habitat. Interest in the program continues to be very strong. During this reporting period alone, Ducks Unlimited biologists and agronomists have worked directly with more than 10 different farmers and ranchers interested in CCLIP2. To date, a total of approximately 83% (\$1,031,390.05 / \$1,250,790.00) of awarded funds have been obligated to 53 different CCLIP2 agreements for grazing infrastructure and cover crop seeding costs. Direct benefits of the 53 projects underway include enhancement of 14,560.5 acres of cropland (137% of goal: 14,560.5 / 10,560) and 18,016.3 acres of adjacent grasslands (474% of goal: 18,016.3 / 3,800).
